How to connect Service Providers to WAYF

The intended audience for this document are people involved in getting a service connected to the WAYF Identity federation.

1. **A precise description of your service in both Danish and English** (http://wayf.dk/wayfweb/udarbejdelse_af_formalsbeskrivelse.html)
2. **A name for the service in Danish and English**
3. **Contact-info, so WAYF can get in touch with the right people on your side**
4. **A SSL-certificate** (see http://wayf.dk/wayfweb/certifikat_politik.html)
5. **Metadata about your service. Either as 'raw' metadata or an URL pointing to it**
6. **Get acquainted with the WAYF attributes** (<http://wayf.dk/wayfweb/attributoversigt.html>)

When all of the above is prepared and clear you can connect to WAYF using the work flow below

1. **Contact sekretariat@wayf.dk stating your interest and the above information.**
2. **Within 1-3 working days you will be contacted to negotiate what WAYF-attributes you will need to authorize users accessing to your service. We use the 'least possible' principle in negotiation.**
3. **When the number of required attributes has been agreed, the WAYF sekretariat puts you in contact with the WAYF technical staff. If needed they will assist you with setting up the test environment (test-IdP etc.).**
4. **Your service is tested against the WAYF Test-IdP**
5. **When all tests have been conducted successfully, the WAYF sekretariat is contacted**
6. **The sekretariat requests the connection to be moved to the quality assurance environment (QA) which is a clone of the production setup. You will be notified of this.**
7. **A set of tests are conducted. When succesfull all technical preparations are done.**
8. **The contract must be signed by both the service provider and WAYF before the connection is moved to production level.**
9. **The sekretariat orders for the service to be connected to the production environment - the service provider will be notified. There will be a retention period from QA to Production**
10. **The newly connected service is announced on the WAYF web site and information is send to all connected identity providers.**
